

#### **Grant Review Process**



- Blind review of applications
- No identifying information allowed
- Apps cannot reveal name of district, school or applicant
- Scored by a team of Beyond the Books board members

#### **Rubric Considers:**

- Innovation
- Project description and clarity
- Impact on student achievement
- Collaboration with others
- Effectiveness of teaching strategies
- Sustainability of program (or justification for a one-time event)
- Evaluation of outcomes
- Realistic and complete itemized budget that aligns with program goals




